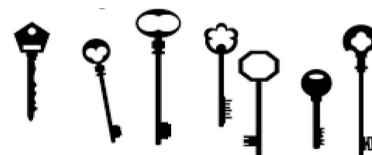
Barbara presents *7 keys to learning* with lots of practical suggestions to assist students at all levels, including those with specific learning challenges.
