Rae will share findings from her PLD projects focused on the use of bilingual and additional language acquisition pedagogies, and provide examples from the use of Pasifika dual language books to facilitate Pasifika children's biliteracy development. The impact of PLD on teachers' transanguaging pedagogies and on children's educational experiences will be shared, and implications for Māori, Pasifika and other bilingual learners in Ōtākou/Otago schools will be discussed.
